

### Emergency Supplies Checklist

- Batteries for radios, flashlights, etc.
- Blankets or sleeping bags
- Can opener (non-electric)
- Candles and matches
- Cash (ATM's may not be working)
- Copies of vital records. Make sure originals are stored safely.
- Essential medications
- Evacuation plan, including out of area contact separated family members can check in with
- Extra pair of eyeglasses if worn
- Extra pair of house and car keys
- Flashlights w/ batteries
- Fire extinguisher, A-B-C type
- First aid kit
- Food
- Food , water and leash for pets
- Garden hose
- Knife/razor blades
- Paper towels, plates, and cups
- Paper/pens/stamps
- Personal hygiene supplies
- Portable radio AM/FM
- Portable stove (**CAUTION:** before using fire to cook, make sure there are no gas leaks. **NEVER** use charcoal indoors!)
- Sand and sandbags for residences in low-lying areas prone to flooding.
- Sanitation supplies
- Sturdy shoes, gloves and change of clothing
- Tent
- Tools such as pliers and a wrench
- Water purification kit
- Water, at least 1 gallon per person per day. A week's supply is recommended
